

## PROCLAMATION

HIS EXCELLENCY, THE HONOURABLE EMMERSON DAMBUDZO MNANGAGWA, President of the Republic of Zimbabwe and Commander-in-Chief of the Defence Forces of Zimbabwe.

WHEREAS, in terms of section 2(1) of the Commission of Inquiry Act [*Chapter 10:07*], it is provided that, the President may, when he considers it advisable, by proclamation, appoint a Commission of Inquiry consisting of one or more commissioners;

AND WHEREAS, the President issued a proclamation in Statutory Instrument 91 of 2024, establishing the Commission of Inquiry into the matter of Local Governance by Harare City Council since 2017;

AND WHEREAS, the substitution of Commissioner Nobert Phiri to the Commission of Inquiry has become necessary:

NOW, THEREFORE, under and by virtue of the powers vested in the President as afore said, I do, by this proclamation amend the proclamation published in Statutory Instrument 91 of 2024, by the deletion on the Schedule of the name “Nobert Phiri” and substitution of it by the name “Tafadzwa Charles Hungwe”.
